The woman, Susette of Colvill
Band Lake Superior who married
a Member of the Indian Band of
the Lake of Two Mountains ceased
on her Marriage to be a member
of the Band to which she formerly
belonged; and, therefore as by the terms
of the Treaty the annuity is only
payable to the Chiefs and their families
she is not entitled to the same.
