Mr. Inspector McCall, in  
 his Annual Report dated the  
 20th November last, states that the  
 Indians of the Peace River Band  
 were very greatly disappointed  
 in not receiving the implements  
 ordered for a year ago, especially  
 the gun-bags and axes, which  
 they require very much. Some  
 of these implements had been  
 stored at The Hudson Bay Company  
 Post at Day Head, by the  
 Agent who claimed that the Indians  
 were not entitled to these articles under  
 Treaty, and, therefore, according
