A return has been received from the teacher of the Eagle Lake School for September quarter last. The Department was under the impression that this school was to be discontinued at the close of the fiscal year as in your draft estimates you placed a foot note which read that "the schools at Canoe River and Eagle Lake are closed." As Mr. Fox has apparently kept the school open during the whole quarter, the Department would like to know whether it is likely to be continued or not as no provision is made for it in the estimates.

Be good enough to state whether any notice was given of the intention to close this school or not as in the meantime payment of the teacher, Mr. Fox's, salary was with held.
