



I beg to draw the attention of the Royal Commission to the fact that the plan accompanying Interim Report No. 44, shows an area of 60.3 acres in the Shalalth Indian Reserve No. 1 of the Seton Lake Band which has been applied for by the Pacific Great Eastern Railway Company for Townsite purposes. Mr. D'Arcy Tate, Vice President of the Company, has been informed that the consideration of this application will probably require to remain in abeyance until the reserve has been finally confirmed after necessary action by the Royal Commission.
