
Description of Right-of-Way for Curiboo Rosa through Boston Bar Indian Reserve No. 1. (Tuckkwiowhus). Sections 14 & 23. Tp. 10, R.26, W. 6th Mer.

Commencing at a point (Sta. 1292 + 41.6) in the South boundary of Boston Bar Indian Reserve No. 1. (Tuckkwiowhum).

Sections 14 & 23. Tp. 10. R.26. W. 6th Meridian. said point lying 14.3 feet west from the south-east corner of said Indian Reserve; thence along the following described courses:-

to a point (3ta. 1330 + 73.0) on the south bank of Anderson Creek, being the north boundary of said Indian Reserve, a total length of 3831.4 feet; having a width of thirty-three (33) feet on either side of the above described centre line and containing 5.80 scres, more or less, all as shown coloured red on the plan attached hereto.
