

*[Copy of the resolution unanimously passed at the close of the meeting of the Girls' Friendly Society Associates, November 15th 1886.]*

"A misunderstanding having hitherto prevailed among the Associates of the Girls' Friendly Society, they are much grieved to learn to-day the true circumstances of the late scandal at Lansdowne Terrace and desire to put on record an expression of the same, and record their approval of the action taken by their Patron, the Bishop, in the matter, at the same time expressing their deep grief at the course taken by Mr. Hind, the ex-Chaplain, then in charge of the Girls' Friendly Society House.

*"Also Resolved,*—That a copy of the same be sent to Mr. Hind, so that it may be understood throughout the Diocese that the Society censure the said proceedings which have taken place since Easter."
