

SECTION XXXI.

Should more than one member rise to speak at the same time, the Chairman shall at once and without appeal determine who is entitled to the floor.

SECTION XXXII.

On a point of order being raised while a member is speaking, the member speaking shall at once take his seat ; the point of order shall be stated by the member raising it, and the Chairman shall without further debate decide thereupon.

SECTION XXXIII.

In business discussions each member shall be allowed to speak twice, but no member shall speak for the second time until all the members desiring to speak once have done so.

SECTION XXXIV.

No amendment can be received after an amendment to an amendment.

SECTION XXXV.

The following motions shall be put from the chair immediately, without debate:—

To adjourn simply ;

To lay on the table ;
