

CHURCHES.—Church of England is a handsome brick building. Rev. Dr. Schultz, Incumbent.

SCHOOLS.—The high school of the second district of Elgin is located in this village, and united with its public school. The building is very respectable and most eligibly situated on an eminence, overlooking the town and vicinity. The attendance of pupils in each department is large and the schools well sustained.
