A Message from his Majesty's Council by their Clerk.

Mr. Speaker, His Majesty's Council have sent down the Bill Intituled an Act for raising a fund for defraying the expence of printing the Laws of this Island, and for other purposes therein mentioned agreed to, and then withdrew.

*Mr. Macgowan*, communicated to the House the answer of his Excellency the Lt. Governor to the Addresses of the House on the subject of certain Items in the Public Accounts.

On Motion of *Mr. Bagnall*, the House thereupon *Resolved*, That the answer of his Excellency the Lt. Governor to the Addresses of this House, respecting the monies charged in the Public Accounts, allowed the Post Office, Adjutant General of Militia and *Thos. D. Cowdell, &c.* is highly satisfactory, and evince the strongest proofs of his Excellency's ardent desire of meeting the wishes of this House on all occasions.

On Motion of *Mr. Holland*, *Ordered*, That the House do enter upon consideration of the Bill establishing the Limits, Bounds and Meets of Townships in this Island," the next Session.
