and do all other matters and things which he shall think necessary and convenient for the making, effecting, preserving, improving, completing, what may be necessary and using the said Canal, in pursuance and within the true meaning of your making and prethis Act, doing as little damage as may be in the execution of the several serving the Canal. powers to him hereby granted.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That after any Lands or Grounds shall be set out and ascertained to be necessary for officersuperintending making and completing the said Canal, and other purposes and conve-may contract for the surrender to His Maniences herein before mentioned, the Officer aforesaid is hereby empower-jesty of any lands reed to contract, compound, compromise, and agree with all bodies politic, quired communities, corporations, aggregate or sole, guardians, and all other person or persons for themselves, or as Trustees, not only for and on behalf of themselves, their Heirs and Successors, but also for and on behalf of those whom they represent, whether infants, lunatics, ideots, femmes covert, or How the lands of fem other person or persons who shall occupy, be possessed of, or interested in, mes covert, infants, &c. may be transferany Lands or Grounds which shall be set out, or ascertained as aforesaid, red. for the absolute surrender to His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors of so much of the said Land as shall be required, or for the damages which he, she, or they may reasonably claim in consequence of the said intended composition may be Canal, Locks, Towing Paths, Rail-ways, and other Constructions and made by contract for damages. Erections, being cut and constructed in and upon his, her, or their respective Lands, and that all such contracts, agreements, and surrenders, shall be valid and effectual in Law, to all intents and purposes whatsoever, any Law, Statute, or Usage, to the contrary notwithstanding.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, That such parts and portions of Land or Lands, covered with Water, as may be so ascer-Lands ascertained tained and set out by the Officer employed by His Majesty as necessary and set out as required for the Canal to to be occupied for the purposes of the said Canal; and also, such parts be vested in His Maand portions as may, upon any alteration or deviation from the line orgi-jesty. nally laid out for the said Canal, be ascertained and set out as necessary for the purposes thereof, shall be forever thereafter vested in His Majesty, His Heirs and Sucessors.

IV.
