ROYAL WEDDING FOR FEBRUARY

Several Royalties Will Not Attend Princess Alice's Marriage at Windsor.

London, Jan. 21.—Feb. 10, the anniversary of the wedding of Queen Victoria, has been set as the date of the marriage of Princess Alice, daughter of the late Duke of Albany, and Prince Alexander of Teck, youngest brother of the Princess of Wales.

There is no truth in the story, according to which the King and Queen of Wurtemberg, who are among the nearest relatives of the royal couple, Princes of Teck, are to be present at the wedding.


