

THE CHINESE AT HOME.

Their Women Are Extremely Modest in Both Dress and Behavior. There are many Chinese, or many kinds of China, but the only one I expected to find was the one I did not see.

On the other hand, I saw the women at every sort of labor, squatted upon the river bank, climbing the boys, wrestling, frolicking, rowing boats with their feet, wading streams, and never having any sense of shame.

So like little children were they that I could not bear to think them different in any respect—there in the garden where baby girls only fetched a dollar in the market, until the price rose recently in Shanghai, because of the employment of girls in the manufacture of opium.
