

### Scientific and Aselul.

ESCALLOPED TURKEY.—Moisten breadcrumbs with a little milk; butter a pan and
put in it a layer of crumbs, then a layer of
chopped (not very fine) cold turkey seasoned
with salt and pepper, then a layer of crumbs,
and so on until the pan is full. If any gravy
or dressing has been left, add it. Alake
thickening of one or two eggs, half a cup of
milk, and quarter of a cup of butter and
bread crumbs; season and spread it over the
top; cover with a pan, bake half an hour
and then let it brown.

REWAD PURDING.—Put old pieces of bread

and then let it brown.

BREAD PUDDING.—Put old pieces of bread into the oven and let them get crisp, so that they will crush down like meal. Mir and pour one pint of boiled milk over it. Let it stand over night. Well grease a mould and dredge flour over it. Stick raisins round according to fancy. To the mixture add one tablespoonful of currants, one tablespoonful of finely mixed suet, one dessertspoonful of sugar, a pinch of ground ginger, and a little or minery mixed suct, one dessertspoonful of sugar, a pinch of ground ginger, and a little scraped nutmeg. Mix thoroughly, put in the mould, and place in the middle of a saucepan with boiling water—just enough to keep it from burning. Steam for two hours.

MORE FRUIT AND FEWER PIES.—Why not, instead of having so many pies, have the fruit prepared with only cream and sugar? It is certainly healthier for children, and just as good. Also, why not get all the vegetables from the garden that will be required for dinner early in the morning, before the tables from the garden that will be required for dinner early in the morning, before the sun shines warm, even if some of the morning house-work waits. For the house-work will be done in the shade, while the garden will be in the hot rays of the sun. And in the evening considerable can be done toward the next morning's breakfast, which will save a great deal of hurry and time in the morning

BUCKWHEAT CAKES.—One quart buck-wheat flour; four tablespoonfuls yeast; one tablespoonful salt; one handful Indian meal; two tablespoonfuls molasses—not syrup; warm water enough to make a thin batter; beat very well, and set to rise in a warm place; if the batter is the least sour in the morning stir in a very little soda dissolved in hot water; mix in an earthen crock, and leave some in the bottom each morning—a cupful or so—to serve as sponge for the next night, instead of getting fresh yeast. In cold weather this plan can be successfully pursued for a week or ten days without setting a new supply. Of course you add the usual quantity of flour, etc. every night, and beat up well. Do not make your cakes too small. Buckwheats should be of a generous size. Some put two-thirds buckwheat, one-third oatmeal, omitting the Indian.

MOTH PREVENTIVE.—A correspondent of the "Furniture Gazette" recommends the following remedy for exterminating moths in carpets and furniture: "After some years," says the writer, "I found a sure preventive of moth in pitch paper, the same as roofers use. The moth will live and grow on cayenne pepper and tobacco, while I never could see that the use of these articles kept the moth miller out. The plan for the furniture dealer or housewife is to cut the paper in slips and place about the room, under and behind sofas, chairs, etc.; this should be done as early as the middle of April and in warmer climates earlier. If the dealer wishes to make parlous suits moth proof he should place on the inside of backs of chairs and seats small strips of the pltch paper, and rest assured that the miller will not select these places to deposit eggs. It is the miller that is the foundation of all the mischief."
