CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

The past week has been characterized by a steady trade in lumber at the lower basis of prices which has been established. That there has been no further cutting on any account is regarded as a recognition of the healthy conditions underlying the market. The stock of white pine held at the mills at the beginning of the summer season was by no means large, and the consumption promises to make heavy inroads upon the season's production. One or two Michigan dealers have recently purchased considerable blocks of white pine in the Georgian Bay district. Building operations are responsible for a large local consumption of lumber. In Toronto, for instance, the building permits issued during the first half of this year exceeded all previous records, being valued at \$2,629,102 and including 728 dwellings, 25 factories and 23 warehouses. Keener competition is being experienced from yellow pine, but there is now some hope that the Government will protect the Canadian industry by an import duty on United States lumber.

Michigan hardwoods are being shipped into Western Ontario, and with a decreased consumption, the demand for the product of the Canadian mills is slow. Prices, however, are not showing much weakness, and there is a fair demand for soft elm and birch. Hemlock is still held at \$12.50 at the mills.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The spruce lumber market shows no signs of becoming more active in the near future. Shipments from St. John, N.B., to the United Kingdom are exceptionally
