Bill No. C-39, An Act to amend the Income Tax Act.

On motion of Mr. Cardiff, seconded by Mr. Hodgson, it was ordered,— That the name of Mr. Lambert be substituted for that of Mr. MacRae on the Standing Committee on Public Accounts.
