ENERGY ADMINISTRATION ACT

MEASURE TO ESTABLISH

Hon. Marc Lalonde (Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources) moved that Bill C-103, to amend the Petroleum Administration Act and to enact provisions related thereto, be read the second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Energy Legislation.

He said: Madam Speaker, I am honoured to participate once again in this most important energy debate. This is the third bill which we are considering in the past two days, and I appreciate the speed with which members of the House have dealt with them.

THE ROYAL ASSENT

Madam Speaker: I have the honour to inform the House that when the House went up to the Senate chamber, the Deputy Governor General was pleased to give, in Her Majesty's name, the Royal Assent to the following bills:

Bill C-88, an act respecting loans to farmers—Chapter No. 92;

Bill C-89, an act to amend the National Housing Act and the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation Act—Chapter No. 93;

Bill C-97, an act to amend the Federal-Provincial Fiscal Arrangements and Established Programs Financing Act, 1977 and to provide for payments to certain provinces—Chapter No. 94.

It being six o'clock, the House stands adjourned until twelve o'clock noon tomorrow, pursuant to order made earlier this day.

At 6.04 p.m. the House adjourned, without question put, pursuant to Standing Order.
