I beg to advise you that I am just in receipt of information to the effect that the revised By-Laws enacted by this Corporation on November 7th last, have been given official sanction by the Secretary of State of Canada, to date from January 2nd 1925. In the case of the authority for Supplementary Letters Patent to authorise Clause (f) in the Charter, that has been temporarily deferred in order to allow us the benefit of reduced fees (from \$100 to \$10) that will result from an Order-in-Council going through within a brief period.
