

MARKET FOR WHEAT RALLIED SOMEWHAT

Improved Demand for Hard Winter Grades Had Much Influence.

CHICAGO, Oct. 7.—Improved demand for hard winter grades for export and milling had much influence in rallying the wheat market. Closing prices were firm, 3-5c to 1-3c above last night. Corn finished 1-3c to 1-5c up and oats with a gain of 1-3c to 1-5c but provisions 12-15c to 37-40c down.

Active call for U. S. hard winter wheat developed quite unexpectedly here and southwest. The grain, which is usually heavy and dry, seems to be meeting with special favor in Europe, rivaling Canadian spring wheat here of the hard winter variety. The season up to now.

American receipts northwest have continued to diminish helped by the fact that the season's crop was only two-thirds of that of last year. A big increase of the season's available supply, however, has been in favor of the bears, and there were also advices of beneficial rains in Argentina. Spasmodic weakness from such causes disappeared, however, in the last hour, chiefly on account of the better export and millers' call.

Corn's Strength Upheld.

Corn after suffering a sharp break, had a strong upturn. Rain that was said to be damaging forage in Kansas and elsewhere was responsible for the rally. There were reports, too, that Argentine corn arriving at New York was in poor condition. The early rally in prices came mainly from a speculative short selling on the part of traders. In the oats crowd local millers who hammered values early paid later for their crowed. A bullish estimate of the French crop had considerable effect.

Provisions gave away under liquidating sales, especially of lard. It was not until after many stop loss orders had been executed and the grain market had begun to rally that the big hedges took a hand in furnishing support.
