

## MURDERED HIS LITTLE BABY.

That is the Awful Charge Hanging Over the Head of H. H. Stewart of Cleveland.

## LEFT HIS WIFE TWO WEEKS AGO.

Took the Babe From Beside His Sleeping Mother and the Body Was Found in the Lake.

New York, Oct. 18.—Harry Stewart, a 26 years old, of Cleveland, Ohio, was arrested yesterday on a charge of murder. Stewart left his wife and family in Cleveland two weeks ago, and came to New York, supposedly bringing with him his 3-month-old girl baby.

Soon after a dispatch was received here asking the police to locate him, as he had written to say he had been found. He was found working for the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company as a stenographer. He refused to give any information about his child.

## A Charge of Murder.

Last night the Detective Bureau here received the following despatch:

"Arrive on charge of murder Harry Howland. Stewart's body of child has been found. Do not delay. He may be advised and skip. (Signed) George C. Conner, Chief of Detectives."

After a conference with the police, Stewart refused to make any statements. He was arraigned and remained for 48 hours.

## The Murdered Child.

Cleveland, Ohio, Oct. 18.—The body of a 3-month-old baby, with its throat cut from ear to ear, was found floating in a lake near the city of Toledo, Ohio, yesterday afternoon. The police allege that it is that of a newborn child. A week ago Monday night Stewart, a stenographer, left his home in the morning, took the child from beside his sleeping mother, and left the house. He was traced to Philadelphia, but refused to return.

Cincinnati, Oct. 18.—Judge Ferri said yesterday as he converted a number of foreign citizens to the United States' flag:

## St. Louis Engineers' Banquet.


