REPORT OF COMMITTEE ON WORKS OF MERCY.

The Committee on Works of Mercy beg to report what they feel is needed by the Church in this Diocese, leaving the question of the mode of supplying these wants to the consideration of the Synod:

1st. As regards the country. Young people come into the city from the country for employment; it is almost impossible for the Parochial Clergy to follow them as they move about. If there were a Committee of Ladies and Gentlemen to whom they could be directed, who would take trouble to look after them, to direct them to good boarding places and to connect them with congregations, much good might be done—much evil averted.
