One Divorce Law For The Dominion

A bill to place divorce in Canada within the executive domain of the civil courts has been drafted under government instructions and will be before parliament shortly by W. F. Nickle, M. P., with the backing of the government.

The new bill gives jurisdiction throughout Canada over all matters relating to divorce to the exchequer court of Canada where either of the parties is domiciled in Canada and the superior court of each province where either party is domiciled in such province. In New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, where divorce courts already are established, these courts shall continue and after that the divorce courts for these provinces will be the supreme court of Nova Scotia and the King's bench di-

RECENT DEATHS

George H. McEwen.

Moncton, April 25—George H. McEwen, retired C. G. W. official, died this morning at his home at Shediac Cape, following a stroke of paralysis. He was freight agent for the C. G. R. at Truro for eighteen or twenty years. He was sixty-three years of age and is survived by his wife, Mrs. E. C. Cole and Mrs. L. B. Read of this city are sisters.

Many will be sorry to learn of the death of Archie McW. Campbell, which occurred yesterday at the General Public Hospital after a week's illness of pneumonia. He was thirty-five years of age. Besides his wife and three small children, he leaves his father, Charles M. Campbell, of this city, four brothers—Guy S. Gordon and Roy, of this city, and Walter, of the United States navy, and one sister, Mrs. John Pierce, of this city. Another brother, Fred Campbell, made the supreme sacrifice in France.

Mrs. G. C. VanWart of Fredericton, received a telegram on Friday stating that her niece, Miss Sybil Fenwick, of Easton, Me., was critically ill with pneumonia and a short while after received another one saying that she had passed away. Miss Fenwick was only seventeen years of age.

The death of Mrs. Daniel Driscoll took place at her home in Musquash, April 28, at the age of eighty years. Besides her husband she leaves three sons and four daughters, including Mrs. Tina Driscoll, West St. John.

The death of Mrs. E. M. Carle took place yesterday afternoon at the summer home of Rev. W. R. Robinson at Grand Bay. She has been a housekeeper for Mr. Robinson, and prior to going to Grand Bay she had lived in this city. She is survived by her husband.

MAKING PROGRESS WITH THE LEAGUE OF NATIONS.

At the session of the peace conference yesterday President Wilson explained the revised covenant, saying that most of the changes were in phraseology and not in substance. The president then moved that Sir James Eric Drummond be the first secretary-general, and moved that the powers name representatives to form a committee of nine to prepare plans for organizing the league and establishing the seat of the league.

The Japanese delegates pressed for recognition of the equality of races and M. Bourgeois of the French delegation said that France would sign the pact, although her amendment requesting an international police force and limitation of armaments had failed of adoption. The Japanese and French amendments were withdrawn to be acted on by the league itself.

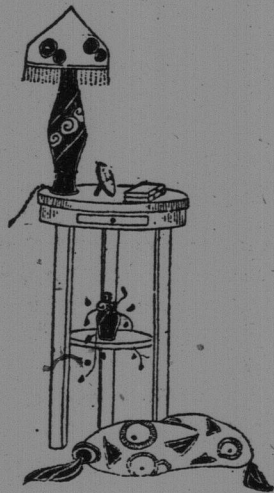

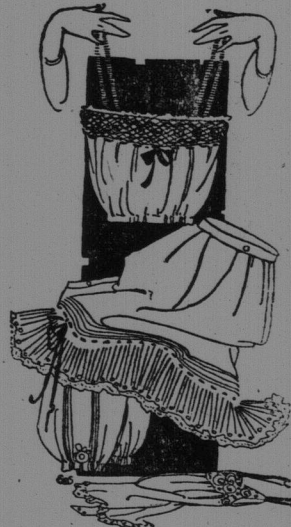
