We have tested beers repeatedly in this direction, placing the bottles into direct sunlight, and testing the same after one, two, three and five minutes exposure, found that the beer with three and five minutes exposure became undrinkable, on account of the peculiar odor developed. account of the peculiar odor developed.

The detrimental effect of light upon

beer can be successfully counteracted by the employment of brown or dark colored glass bottles, and such bottles are therefore recommendable."
