

The Murderous Museulmans are Ge

Candia, Island of Creta. Oct 28.—
Four more of the Mussulmana, convicted of taking part in the massicre of British soldiers on September 6, were executed to-day. In addition four Bashi Bazoukel have been sentenced to twenty vears' imprisonment at hard labor. Since the departure of the Turkish troop a number of additional guilty Mussulmana have been decovered daily. It also uppeare that the Turkish officers appropriated the valuables looted by the soldiers. On Cotober 18 several Mussulmane were also hanged for participation in the mussacer of September 6.
