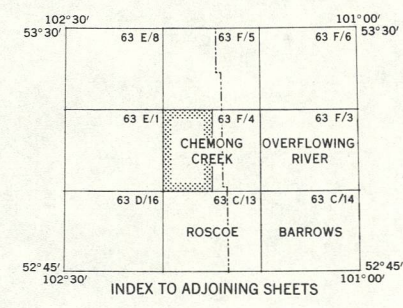
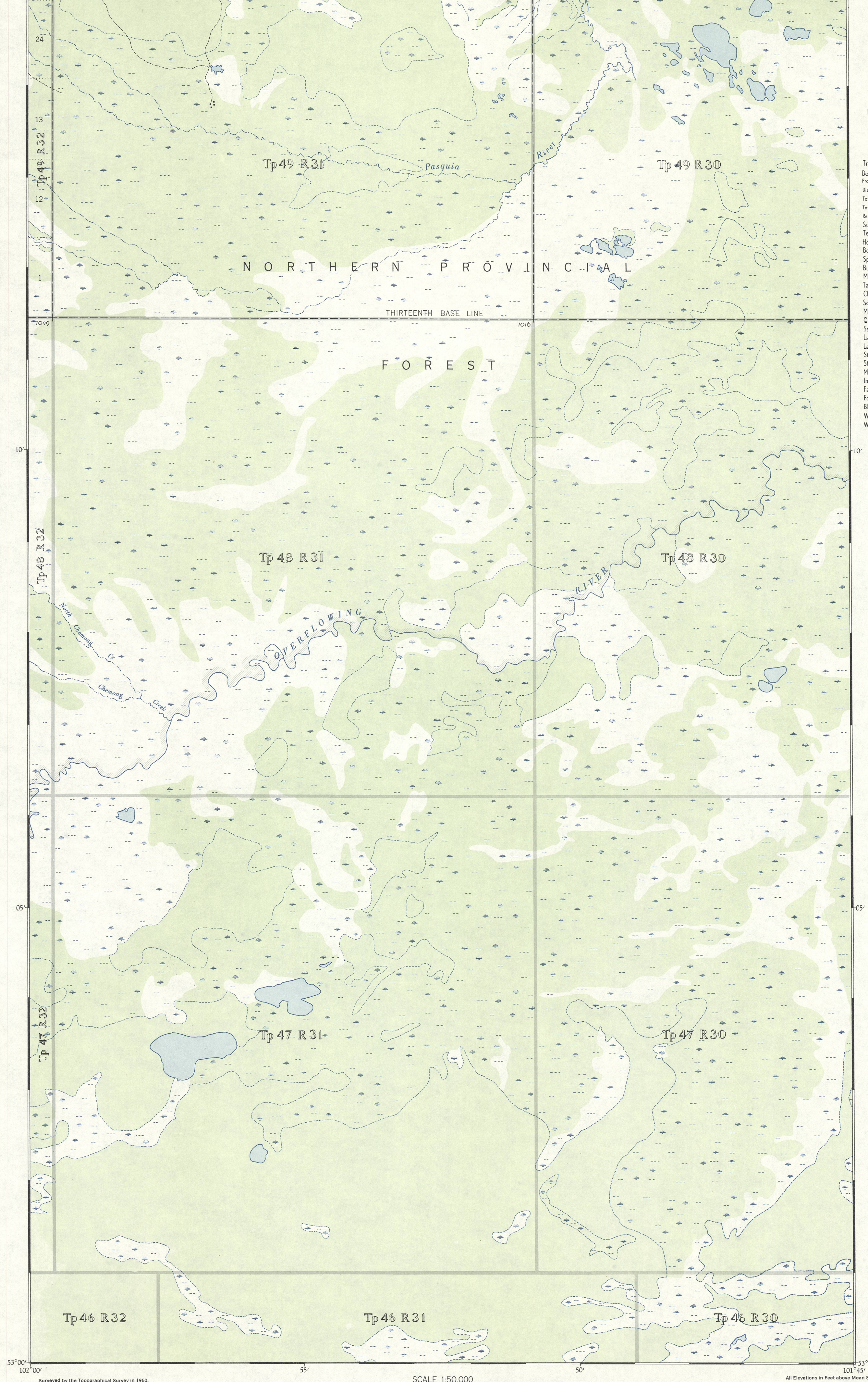

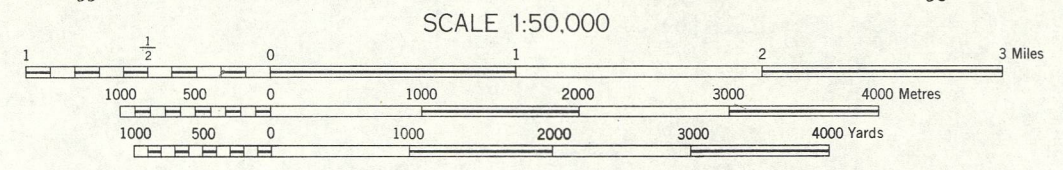


MAGNETIC DECLINATION 15°21' EAST,
