Our school system, including the buildings, inspectors, teachers and curriculum, is just as good, and I believe in some respects, more advanced than that of the province of Ontario. In this province, with respect to the problem of the education of the non-English child; greater effort has been put forth a real instrument for Canadianisation than has been ever thought of in the province of Ontario; and yet in that province there are substantially as many non-English as there are here and the problem has been with you for more than a generation.
