The denomination should have at least ten young men at our Educational Institutions, studying with special reference to the Ohristian ministry. Men of good common sense, acceptable speaking talents, of undoabted piety, and giving satisfactory evidence that they are called by the Head of the Church to consecrate themselves to this great work, are
