Washington March 31.—Three hundred thousand organized miners in the fituminous coal fields of Pennsylvan. Ohio, Indiana, Illilinois, Iowa, Misuri, Kansas, Okiahoma and Arkansa quit work tonight.

The miners, members of the United the Workers of America, declared he walk-out was not a strike, but merely a suspension of work pending an arrangement between themselves and the operators, of a wage scale for another year—the old scale having expired with the month of March. The men demand an increase of pay in some instances of five cents a ton and in other instances more, and certain changes in working conditions.

Confidence was expressed by the operators that there will be no general coal famine, large supplies of fuel having been secured in anticipation of the walk-out.

While the miners predicted the suspension would be cut short by a growth string the propersion would be cut short by a prompt signing of wage scales, some of the operators maintained the mines might be kept closed for a month or sixty days or longer.
