

## NEW PROHIBITION ACT STRONGLY ENDORSED

At Meeting of Chatham District Methodists—Repeal of the Scott Act Advocated.

Newcastle, Sept. 6.—The Methodist Chatham district meeting was held here yesterday afternoon and evening. The following grants were recommended from the missionary funds: Richibucto, \$700; Buctouche, \$400; Tabusintac, \$215; Harcourt, \$326; Bonaventure, for fall and winter supply, \$75; Gaspe and Cape Ozor, \$465.

The following, moved by Rev. Dr. Squires and rev. Mr. Lawson, was carried unanimously:

Whereas, a provincial prohibitory law has been recently passed by the government of New Brunswick, and whereas, the Canada Temperance Act seems to display many weaknesses in the counties where it has been tried; and

Whereas, the retention of the Scott Act might endanger the permanency of the provincial act, in view of the conditions of the referendum; therefore

Resolved, that this district endorse the efforts of the electors of Northumberland county to repeal the C. T. A. in order that the provincial measure may come into force.

A number of speakers in the course of the meeting strongly endorsed the government's new prohibition act and urged its adoption in sections where the Scott Act now obtains.

**SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS.**

The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District Entry by letter to the Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency) on certain conditions:

Duties—(1) Six months residence upon cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may reserve a quarter-section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.50 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning a vested patent a 500 acre extra cultivation. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.
