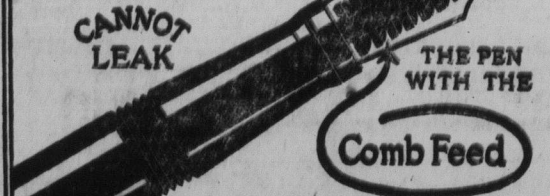

## EVIDENCE COMPLETED IN THE HARRIS MURDER TRIAL

Argument of Counsel Today—Verdict Likely This Afternoon or Evening—Several Witnesses for Defense Say Accused Were Home on Night of Assault—Mr. Lenehan Tells of Meeting Accused Early Next Morning and Evidence Given for Defence in Rebuttal—Depositions Not Admitted.

Evidence in the murder case against Everett Carland and John O'Brien was completed at the court house last evening. The crown rested its case late in the afternoon, and the defense opened immediately. Several witnesses, including members of the family of the accused, testified that both Carland and O'Brien were at their homes about 10:30 o'clock and remained there throughout the night. That Harris was assaulted, for the crown Jeremiah Lenehan testified that he saw the accused on the morning after the assault, between 8:30 and seven o'clock, while Patrick Gorman for the defense said that he walked behind Lenehan on that morning but did not see either of the prisoners. The depositions of the accused were not offered in evidence.

The case will be resumed this morning at ten o'clock, when addresses of counsel will be made.

**Morning Session.**

At the morning session, counsel called attention to a misleading heading in The Telegraph's report of the proceedings on Wednesday. The chief justice said that the error was a regrettable one.

John McLaughlin, the first witness told of being with the deceased on the night of the assault and said that he left him before he was struck.

Miss Carrie Harris sister of the deceased, said that on one occasion she heard the defendant Carland, say: "Each you will be without your supper some day."

Miss Margaret Cohen, the next witness, testified to seeing two men, one of whom was bent over in the vicinity of Cranston avenue the evening of the assault.

Jeremiah Lenehan said that he saw both the accused on the morning of June 15th between 6:30 and 6:45 o'clock.

Henry Evans and Detective Wm. Duncan also gave evidence. The detective was on the stand, when the court adjourned until 2:30 o'clock.

**Afternoon Session.**

The cross-examination of Detective Duncan was continued when the chief justice asked him to recall the date of the trial. He said it was the 14th. It was either the 10 or 11 of the month, he testified.

Dr. Wallace, witness said he was not positive which trip the accused made, but he was sure that his impression was that it was the ten o'clock trip.
