Landru Accused of Many Murders To Delay Trial

Paris, Oct. 31.—Henri-Destree Landru, the French "Bluebird," has launched another strenuous effort to obtain a three-month delay in connection with the thirteen murder charges which won for him his title as a woman slayer. Although his case is set for trial at Versailles on November 8, it was only last Monday that the judges handed to him 50,000 pages of closely written evidence on which the State relies to send him to the guillotine.

Landru, however, insists he has a right to study the evidence just as closely as did the judges, who required four months to digest the dossier. He intends to conduct his own defense, although Deputy Claffery will sit beside him as his legal adviser and is understood to be optimistic regarding the outcome of the trial.
