The Carlist leader Lizaso was captured in a railway car and shot by Republicans.

A telegram from Carlist sources says that General Despuig, commander of a large body of Government troops in Valencia, has been totally defeated by the Carlists, and obliged to retreat to Morla, with loss of 600 killed and wounded, and 450 prisoners.

The British Government are satisfied that the Gwalior prisoner is not Nana Sahib.

Yakob Khan is in close confinement at Kabul.

The Insurgents under Mitre are negotiating with the Buenos Ayres Government.

The loss of the cable steamer La Plata was caused by a heavy sea striking her, tearing away two boats with the davits, thus causing an opening to be made in the side of the steamer.

The French public are generally favorably impressed by MacMahon's message.

Ottawa, Dec. 5. Parliament has been further prorogued till the 18th January, then to consider the state and welfare of the Dominion.

The Dominion Auditor's Report shows a revenue for November of \$2,230,540.74; expenditure \$1,844,780.33.

IN THE GERMAN REICHSTAG yesterday, a bitter attack on the foreign policy of Bismarck was made by the clerical party and called out a spirited reply from the Chancellor.

The Chancellor also announced that the sum for the maintenance of a German legation at the Vatican has been struck out of the budget.
