2ND EPISTLE OF JOHN.

- 1 The elder unto the elect lady and her children,
whom I love in the truth, and not I only, but
- 2 also all they that have known the truth, for the
truth's sake which dwelleth in us and shall be
- 3 with us for ever. Grace be with you, mercy, and
peace from God the Father, and from the Lord
Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and
love.
- 4 I rejoiced greatly that I found of thy children
walking in truth, as we have received a com-
- 5 mandment from the Father. And now I beseech
thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new com-
mandment unto thee, but that which we had
from the beginning, that we love one another.
- 6 And this is love, that we walk after his com-
mandments. This is the commandment. That,
as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should
- 7 walk in it. For many deceivers are entered into
the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is
