℞ Atropinæ sulphat . . . gr. j.
Aque f℥j.

M. Sig.: Four to eight drops in water. (For children).—*Bartholow*.

℞ Lini cantharidis f℥ss.

Sig.: Paint high up over the nape of the neck, a space three inches by two inches, till blistered.—*Harkin*.

℞ Acid. benzoic ℥ij.
Aq. cinnam. f℥vj.

M. Sig.: A tablespoonful three times a day.—*Hartshorne*.

℞ Strychniæ sulphat. . . gr. j.
Acid acetic. gtt. ij.
Sacch. alb. ℥ij.
Aque f℥ij.

M. Sig.: Fifteen to thirty drops for a child of six to twelve years.—*Magendie*.

℞ Ex. rhois aromat. fl . . . f℥iij.
Elix. aromat. f℥iss.
Aq. cinnam. q. s. ad f℥iij.

M. Sig.: Half teaspoonful, to be increased to one teaspoonful, four times a day, after eating.—*Powell*.

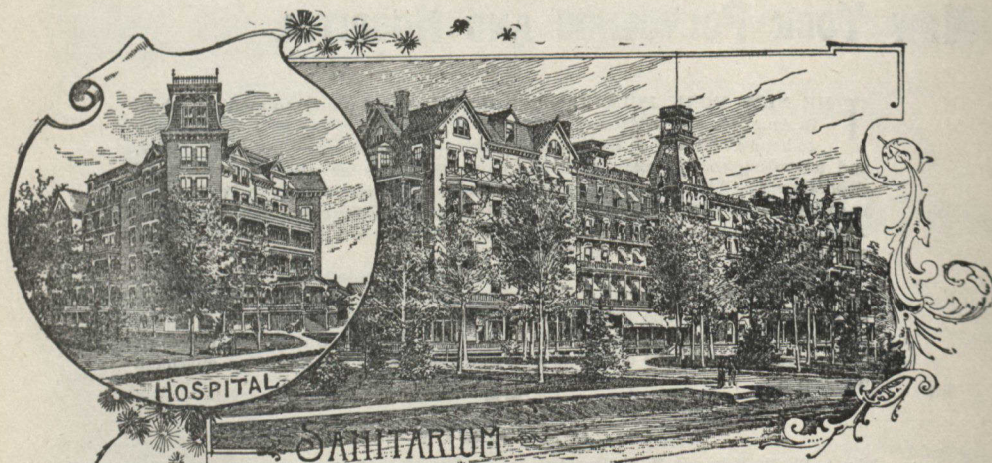
Fever Mixtures.

℞ Potass. bromid ℥iv.
Tr. belladonnæ ℥xxxij.
Tr. aconit. rad. gtt. viij.
Spt. ætheris nit. f℥iij.
Mist. potass. cit. q. s. ad f℥viiij.

M. Sig.: One tablespoonful every two to three hours. Keep in a cool place.—*White*.

℞ Morph. acetat. gr. j.
Sacchar. alb. ℥ij.
Spt. ætheris nit. f℥ij.
Liq. ammonii acet. f℥iv.
Aq. camphoræ q. s. ad f℥viij.

M. Sig.: One tablespoonful every two to three hours.—*Ashurst*.



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
