Rx Atropinæ sulphat gr. j.
Aquaæ fʒ j.
M. Sig.: Four to eight drops in water. (For children.)—*Bartkolow.*

Rx Lini cantharidis fʒ ss.

Sig.: Paint high up over the nape of the neck, a space three inches by two inches, till blistered.—*Harkin.*

Rx Acid. benzoic ʒ ij.
Aq. cinnam..... fʒ vj.

M. Sig.: A tablespoonful three times a day.—*Hartshorne.*

Rx Strychniæ sulphat.... gr. j.
Acid acetic..... gtt. ij.
Sacch. alb ʒ ij.
Aquaæ fʒ ij.

M. Sig.: Fifteen to thirty drops for a child of six to twelve years.—*Magendie.*

R Ex. rhoïs aromat. fl ... fʒ iij.
Elix. aromat..... fʒ iss.
Aq. cinnam.,... q. s. ad fʒ iij.

M. Sig.: Half teaspoonful, to be increased to one teaspoonful, four times a day, after eating.—*Powell.*

Rx Potass. bromid ʒ iv.
Tr. belladonnæ ℥ xxxij.
Tr. aconit. rad..... gtt. viij.
Spt. ætheris nit..... fʒ iij.
Mist. potass. cit...q. s. ad fʒ viij.

M. Sig.: One tablespoonful every two to three hours. Keep in a cool place.—*White.*

Rx Morph. acetat..... gr. j.
Sacchar. alb ʒ ij.
Spt. ætheris nit fʒ ij.
Liq. ammonii acet ... fʒ iv.
Aq. camphoræ...q. s. ad fʒ viij.

M. Sig.: One tablespoonful every two to three hours.—*Ashurst.*
