PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND.

6. In the Province of Prince Edward Island each of the counties following, that is to say:—Prince county, Queen's county and King's county, as they were respectively constituted on the twenty-sixth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, shall be an electoral district and shall each return two members: *See Imperial Orders in Council, passed 26th June, 1873, p. ix. of Statutes of 1873.*

BRITISH COLUMBIA.

7. In the Province of British Columbia there shall be five electoral districts, which shall be designated and constituted as follows, that is to say:—

Electoral districts in British Columbia.

(a) The electoral district of New Westminster, which shall consist of New Westminster district and the coast district, as defined in a public notice issued from the Lands and Works Office in the said colony, on the fifteenth day of December, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, by the desire of the Governor, and purporting to be in accordance with the provisions of the thirty-ninth clause of the "*Mineral Ordinance, 1869*;"

New Westminster.

(b) The electoral district of Cariboo, which shall consist of Cariboo district and Lillooet district, as specified in the said public notice;

Cariboo.

(c) The electoral district of Yale, which shall consist of Yale district and Kootenay district, as specified in the said public notice;

Yale.

(d) The electoral district of Victoria, which shall consist of those portions of Vancouver Island known as Victoria district, Esquimalt district and Metchosin district, as defined in the official maps of those districts which are deposited in the Land Office, Victoria, and are designated respectively, "Victoria District Official Map, 1858," "Esquimalt District Official Map, 1858," and "Metchosin District Official Map, 1858:"
