My claim & possession of this Lot I hold for no less than twenty

which he replied "If that is the case that he would not interfere"
and I am informed since, that he has deposited the prob-
insalment in your office to substantiate his claim on Lot
15. Should have been the case I hope. You Honour will debar-
ably consider my title to that Lot, before a Patent shall be given
to any individual on said tract of Land.
