Personally I believe very strongly that the peace of the world for many, many years, and probably for more than one generation, if not for many more, is now secure. In this belief the people of Canada I think generally share. Why then should we suffer that a large portion of our people should remain longer in a state of utterly unnecessary apprehension to the very great detriment of our strength as a Party, and consequently our usefulness to the Dominion.

Some mistakes and misunderstanding have arisen by reason of small extracts being taken from my speech, rather than the entire reference to the subject. I am attaching hereto copy of what actually was said.

In the above I have sought to express clearly and frankly my own mind on the subject, and I most earnestly hope these views do not diverge seriously from your own.
