
I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant reporting on the qualifications of Mrs. Jerome Martin, who has applied for the position of teacher of the Rossau River Day School.

In reply I beg to say that Mrs. Martin's qualifications appear very meagre, but she may be given a trial at the school from the first of October and the Department will allow a salary of \$300.00 per annum. It is to be distinctly understood that Mrs. Martin's continuance in the position will depend upon the result of her work.

As you were previously informed the Department will allow a rental of \$5.00 per month for the time that the church is in actual use as a school-room; this is not to include the summer holidays of two months.

You will be good enough to report regularly at intervals on this school.
