ADMINISTRATION

9. (a) Discharges under CARO 1029(7) - A ruling was given that in the matter of discharge when, following conviction by civil power, it is found that the soldier is Category "2", the reason for discharge shall be "Having been convicted by civil power".
- (b) Payment of Fines - Civil Courts - Consideration is being given to the amdt of RO 1268 to provide that the payment of fines levied by civil courts against soldiers for civil offences shall be at the discretion of the OC taking into consideration the trg requirements of soldier concerned.
- (c) Detention Barracks - Course of Instruction - Adm arrangements have been completed for a 10-day course and conference for Comd Mil Detention Barracks (excl Pacific Comd) to be held at Aldershot Mil Detention Barracks 15-25 Jun incl.
- (d) Courts Martial - Delays Pending Trial - To obviate unwarranted delays, a proposed RO provides that where an accused has been remanded for the taking of a summary of evidence, or for trial, or for any other reason, he will be paraded daily before the CO until his case is disposed of.
