## SUB - COUNCILS

## PENALTIES

- (a) Any member of the International Court convicted of corrupt practices or other infringement of the rules and regulations of the International Court or its sub-councils shall be liable to expulsion and further severe punishment, such as imprisonment, plus fines.
- (b) Such member shall at no time thereafter be accepted by the International Court or its member nations as a responsible party in any public position or as an agent in any capacity that might have influence in any manner in international affairs of any kind.
- organizations using any member of the International Court to promote their own selfish interests shall be deemed an aggressor of the first degree. Any nation so doing shall be deemed an aggressor in the second degree.

  The International Court shall have the power to demand the handing over of any individuals from any nations for trial and punishment.
- (d) In the case of a nation, the penalty of ostracism would immediately apply, plus the demand for the handing over of all individuals so concerned, for trial by the International Court.
