

Cruise - timber - I.R. No. 7 (Skowishin)  
Squamish Band.

Attached please find resolution (original and 1 copy) of the Squamish Band taken at a Council Meeting on August 22, 1954, releasing the sum of \$100.00 for an air strip cruise of the timber on the above named I.R. No. 7 located in the Squamish Valley.

The Council were advised at this meeting that applications were on hand for timber removal permits. Having in mind the proposed Forest Management Licence application of Empire Mills Limited in this area and the consequent increased value of Reserve timber through construction of access roads in the area: Council decided that no cutting of this timber by sale or permit was indicated at this time: but that an up to date air strip survey cruise should be made for record. An estimate of approximately \$75.00 has been received from the C.D. Schultz Co. Ltd., Forest Engineers of Vancouver, B.C. on this cruise and release of the funds for this purpose is recommended. If approved, accounts will be submitted for payment by voucher.
