movable rock, an invulnerable fortress, which Satan has been attacking for three thousand years only to confirm the Scripture which says "We can do nothing against the truth but for the truth."

When the Lord went into the synagogue at Nazareth and the roll of parchment was handed Him, He read a prophecy concerning Himself, and said: "This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears," but He did not read the final clause of the prophecy, nor has it been since fulfilled; it is still impending. So also the inspired writer has left room in the first verse of Genesis for three hundred or more millions of years between the first and second clause of that verse; what, however, we are assured of by Isaiah is that "He created it not in vain (void)."

The organic remains which have come down to us from a prime creation indicate a very low order of animal life, with subsequent developments as period succeeded period in prehistoric creation, until finally man was brought upon the scene — a triune
