ago, in 1907, a big central building was erected between the Boys' and Girls' Schools, so joining both schools to mark the Diamond Jubilee. One hundred pupils more were admitted, bringing the capacity of the school to 290. Many rooms and dormitories were dedicated to donors and their names were put on the doors. For all these improvements we owe an immense debt of gratitude to the numerous friends of our schools throughout the who'e Church.

Their Aim

→HE Pointe-aux-Trembles Schools are evangelical and their aim is missionary. They have been founded to give to the youth of Quebec a knowledge of the pure gospel of Jesus Christ and so prepare them to be good citizens and true Christians. Among the subjects taught, the Bible has always been kept paramount and one hour is devoted every day to its study. The Roman Catholic pupils, over one hundred in number, follow the religious course of the school. At first they may not give all their attention to it, but the teaching is so directed as to show the points common to Protestants and Catholics. Soon
