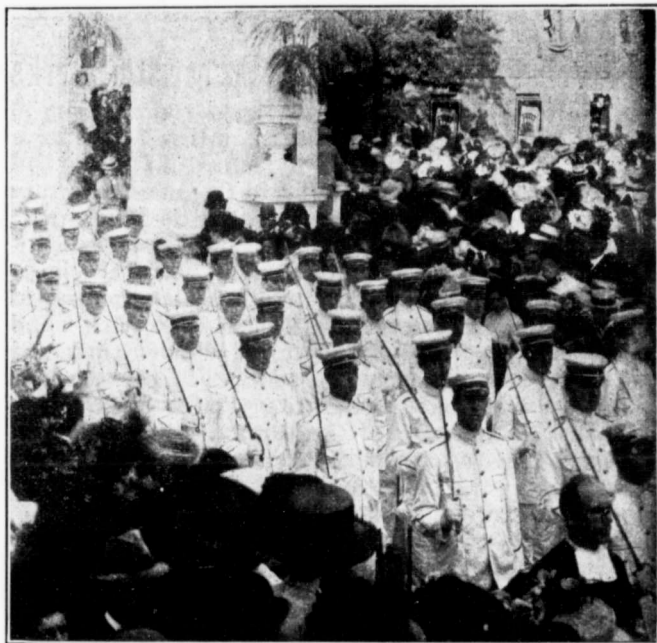


science of to-morrow will reduce to nothingness, or shamefully sinking into the infected filth of sensual pleasures,—such does the great majority of the human race appear to us to day.
