## THE HOUSE MET PURSUANT TO ADJOURNMENT.

### PRAYERS.

A Message was brought from the House of Assembly, by Mr. Whidden, not agreeing to the amendments proposed by this House, to the Bill, entitled, An Act to declare the value of certain Coins current in this Province, and to provide a Legal Tender for the payment of debts.

A Bill, entitled, An Act concerning the Circuit Courts of this Province, was read a second time.

*Ordered*, That the said Bill be referred to a Committee of the whole House presently—the House was adjourned during pleasure and put into a Committee on the said Bill,—after some time the House was resumed, and Mr. Jeffery reported that the Committee had agreed to the said Bill, with amendments.

The amendments were then read, and agreed to.

*Ordered*, That the Deputy-Clerk do carry the said Bill and amendments to the House of Assembly, and desire their concurrence to the said amendments.

A Bill, entitled, An Act to continue the Act relating to Passengers from Great-Britain and Ireland, arriving in this Province, was read a second time.

On motion, *resolved*, that a Conference be desired with the House of Assembly, by Committee, on the said Bill.

A Message was brought from the House of Assembly, by Mr. Whidden, agreeing to the Conference desired by the House.

*Ordered*, That Mr. Cogswell and Mr. Allison, be a Committee of Council to manage the said Conference.

And the Managers went to the Conference, and being returned, Mr. Cogswell reported the substance of the Conference to the House.

Mr. Allison, pursuant to leave given, presented a Petition from William Allen Chipman and others, relative to the Boundaries of Marsh Lands in Cornwallis: which was read, and ordered to lie on the Table.

The House adjourned until to-morrow, at two o'clock.
