With copy of two Despatches from Secretary of State, transmitting Orders in Council, leaving to their operation various Acts of the Legislature; and communicating reasons why Her Majesty has not been advised to confirm the Bill for the relief of the American Loyalists, 11.
4. With copy of Despatch from Secretary of State, allowing the expenditure of £1,500, out of the accruing produce of sales of Crown Lands, towards the erection of a building for a Lunatic Asylum, and other objects of charity, 11.
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
