DISASTROUS EXPLOSION IN TRENTON

APPEAL FOR NURSES IS ISSUED BY THE MAYOR

No Abatement of Influenza--Forty-five Cases in Temporary Hospital, Which Is In Full Operation To-day.

Mayor MacBride last night made a canvass of the city for experienced nurses, but reported this morning that practically every trained nurse in the city is engaged. If there are any nurses, even of limited experience, in or near the city, they are requested to report promptly to Miss McNeill at the temporary hospital at Brant Avenue.

With industries crippled and amusements interdicted under the ravages of Spanish influenza, Brantford has entered upon its second week in the grip of the epidemic. The flu first made its appearance in this city nearly two weeks ago, but not until the first of last week did it assume serious proportions.
