**N.S. CHIEF JUSTICE
REFUSED BAIL TO
J.B. MCLACHLAN**

Chief Justice Harris refused bail to James B. McLachlan, former secretary of the United Mine Workers of America in Nova Scotia, and long a labor leader in the Province, after McLachlan had been sentenced to two years in the Dorchester penitentiary by Mr. Justice Mellish. The former mine worker's secretary was convicted during the present sessions of the Supreme Court of "seditious libel" and his counsel J.A. Walker, applied for bail pending an appeal to the court of Criminal Appeal in Nova Scotia, for a reversal of the verdict in his case.

Vancouver, B.C. Oct 29—That he had very grave doubts as to the fate that will befall the proposed church union bill if opposed on the floor of Parliament by such a formidable and influential body of Presbyterians as has already expressed its opposition, was the declaration yesterday of Rev. Ed. McLaren, D.D. for many years secretary of the church union committee and a former supporter of organic union.

An expert committee of the imperial conference, which has been studying the question under the chairmanship of the foreign secretary Curzon, has drawn up plans which are believed to meet the request. The plans will be submitted next week to the full conference, which is expected to approve them.

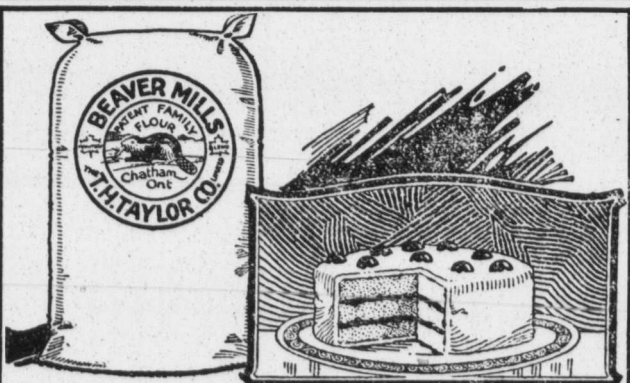
