market strength was manifest in the market throughout the entire trading session today, and nearly all the important stocks scored substantial advances. Union Pacific was the leader being the most active and the strongest stock on the list. The market was excellent, and it seems as if very much higher prices for this security will prevail. Extreme bullishness on this stock—and, in fact, on the general list—is in evidence, and it is very likely that near future will witness further advances in a number of stocks. Early estimates of the bank statement were quite pessimistic, and while the showing was poor it was not quite so bad as expected. Surplus reserves decreased \$3,000,000. Total assets increased \$1,000,000, only \$571,000. Loans increased \$3,623,000, and cash decreased about \$2,292,000. The loss in cash was not indicated in the preliminary estimates, and it was less than the estimates made this morning. It is entirely probable that a variety of conflicting estimates may be given. The statement is, however, not very significant, and a readjustment is looked for in the bank statement of

next week. Copper showed a considerable strength today, and rallied well. St. Paul also showed good strength and we believe this stock will sell very much better. There was nothing in the news of material interest. Money rates
