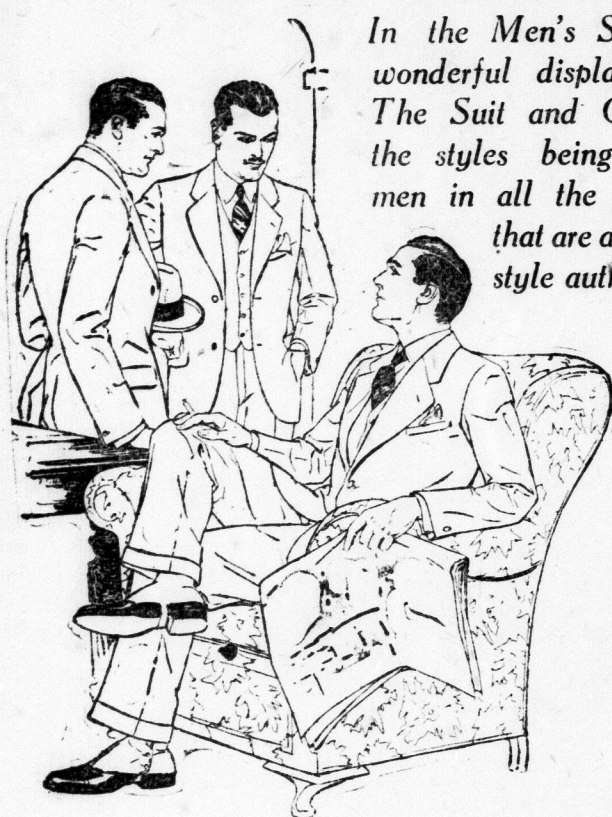

RACE GAMBLERS OF CORK

BLOCK TRAFFIC IN STREETS

Police Needed to Keep Order as Throgs Gather to Talk "Form."

THREE ARE FINED

Associated Press Despatch. Cork, Oct. 8.—At a hearing at the defendants were booked, accused of violating the law, betting bets on horse races, the

superintendent of the civic guard of Cork asserted that "the city has simply gone mad on the betting craze—men, women and children—and something ought to be done about it." Every part of the city was affected, more or less, he averred, and the craze had even penetrated into the pupils of the public schools. Whenever a big race was scheduled traffic in the principal streets was often held up by the people who assembled to discuss the event and to make bets on their favorite animals.

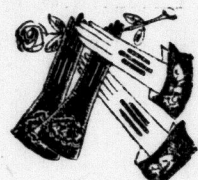
The crowds jammed the thoroughfares, said the superintendent, and stood about for hours with newspapers and racing papers in their hands discussing form, and to make matters worse, he contended, "most of the people to whom I have referred could not afford to bet. When they do so they neglect their cares at home."

The three principal defendants were fined \$100 each.
